Dr. Sylvia Thun is a member of the scientific advisory board of the mibeg Institute for Medicine (University of Cologne, Germany) and lecturer at various universities. She is a member of the GMDS working groups "Medicine-Controlling", "Standardised Terminologies", "Standards for Interoperability and Electronic Health Records", as well as "Medical Documentation and Classification". In 2006 she was awarded the "Medical Informatics" certificate of the GMDS.

Between 2000 and 2004, she was a senior consultant in the healthcare sector, working on topics, such as Integrated Treatment Pathways, Hospital Information System, Diagnostic Related Group, Controlling, Data Protection, Quality Management and Project Management.

During ten years of clinical activity, Sylvia was an EFQM (European Foundation for Quality Management) assessor and a long-term employee at the Institute for Radiological Diagnostics at the Aachen Hospital University.
